To the Gateway family

Matthew 28:5-9 says ...the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. And go quickly and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him. Behold, I have told you."

So they went out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to bring His disciples word. And as they went to tell His disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, "Rejoice!"

Rejoice, Rejoice, again I say Rejoice! Jesus has Risen, Risen from the dead. Death could not hold Him!

Rejoice, rejoice, tell the world. He is RISEN.

Praise God for the Good News of the Gospel, Jesus has transformed my life! The same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead lives in me.

Do you believe? Do you believe that Jesus rose from the dead, that the same Spirit lives in you, when you accept Jesus as Lord of your life? Are you walking in that reality? Greater is HE that is in you than he that is in the world, Hallelujah.

Because the same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead lives in us, then we can do the same works as Jesus and greater! This is the truth of the word of God.

We are encouraged by God to seek His truth, seek the outworking of His truth in our lives.

I love the story of the father who brings his son to the disciples but the disciples couldn't heal him. They had received His authority, they had received the Power through His Spirit but they weren't able (does that sound familiar, don't be discouraged be encouraged). Jesus rebukes the disciples for their lack of faith and exhorts them to pray and fast!

As we read through the New Testament, we will see that the early church prayed and fasted much, it was a lifestyle. We see that not only had the early church been endowed with the power of the Holy Spirit but that the power of God accompanied the preaching of the word!

These are excitingly terrible times, where even churches are deviating from the truth of His Word. Now like never before those true disciples of Jesus need to rise up and stand firm and expect His power to be manifest through their lives for HIS GLORY.
